AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE CITY OF MAROA.

WHEREAS Per the City of Maroa Code of Ordinances:

§ 250-8 Speed limits

- A. General speed restrictions. The speed limits on various streets shall be approved by the City Council, but shall not exceed 20 miles per hour in a school zone or 30 miles per hour on an arterial street, unless otherwise posted.

- B. Special speed limit while passing schools.
 - 1. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour while passing a school zone or while traveling upon any public thoroughfare on or across which children pass going to and from school during school days when school children are present.

 - 2. This subsection shall not be applicable unless appropriate signs are posted upon streets and maintained by the City or state wherein the school zone is located.

WHEREAS The City Council desires clarification in the matter of City speed limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maroa, Macon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City-wide speed limit for all streets within the corporate boundary shall be 30 miles per hour, unless a lower speed limit is otherwise posted.

SECTION 2. Signage shall be erected at the four entrances to the City (East Washington, West Washington, North Wood and South Wood) stating the following:

CITY SPEED LIMIT – 30 MPH – UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED

SECTION 3. The posted speed limit shall be 20 miles per hour for the following streets:

- A. Main Street from Wood Street to Pine Street.
- B. Pine Street from Main Street to Washington Street.
- C. Locust Street from Washington Street to Jefferson Street.

SECTION 4. Signage shall be erected on each block in both traffic directions to clearly indicate the 20 miles per hour speed limit.

SECTION 5. School Zone speed limits will be located on the following streets:

- A. Washington Street from Linden Street to Elm Street.
- B. Main Street from Cedar Street to Elm Street.
- C. Lincoln Street from Cedar Street to Elm Street.
- D. Cedar Street from Lincoln Street to Washington Street.
- E. Wood Street from Lincoln Street to Washington Street.


