Resolution No. 2022/09/12-R1

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION'S TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (ITEP) FUNDING CYCLE 15
FOR PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE FACILITIES.**

Adopted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maroa this 12th Day of September, 2022.

Day of September, 2022.

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WHEREAS, the City of Maroa is seeking **\$2,653,940** in funds from the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) through the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) for Bicycle and Pedestrian Facility improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maroa upon award of the ITEP funds, as the lead sponsor shall be responsible for securing local matching funds and/or in-kind services in an amount equaling at least twenty percent (20%) of costs for PE I & PE II preliminary engineering, utility relocations (as required), construction engineering, and construction, with eighty percent (80%), or more, depending on the community need score, of the costs to be funded by ITEP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maroa upon award of the ITEP funds, as the lead sponsor shall be responsible for securing local matching funds and/or in-kind services in an amount equaling at least fifty percent (50%) of costs for land acquisition (as required) and street lighting with fifty percent (50%), or more, depending on the community need score, of the costs to be funded by ITEP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maroa upon award of the ITEP funds, as the lead sponsor shall be responsible for securing local funds in an amount equaling one hundred percent (100%) of costs for grant ineligible items (as required); and

WHEREAS, the City of Maroa supports believes it is in the best interests of the City of Maroa to support the efforts outlined herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAROA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. The City of Maroa supports the submittal of an application to IDOT's ITEP program for the improvements of bicycle and pedestrian facility along Wood Street from US Rt. 51 to Monroe Street and Main Street from Wood Street to Oak Street.

Section 2. The City of Maroa affirms its commitment to **\$1,089,360** in local funding as the required maximum of twenty percent match for a \$3,743,300 application for ITEP funding.

Section 3. That the Mayor, City Administrator, City Clerk, and City Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign any paperwork necessary for the submittal of the application.

Section 4. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated in this Section 4 as if said recital were fully set forth.

Section 5. The provisions of the Resolution are severable and if any court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any portion of this Resolution to be invalid or unenforceable, said decision shall not affect any portion of this Resolution other than the part declared invalid or unenforceable. The City of Maroa hereby declares that it would have enacted this Resolution even with the invalid or unenforceable portion deleted.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. Any resolution or motion in conflict with this Resolution is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts with this Resolution.
