**RESOLUTION NO. 2022/09/12-R2**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES' OPEN SPACE LAND ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT (OSLAD) GRANT PROGRAM FOR REPLACING THE SPENCER PARK WALKING PATH.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Maroa is seeking \$60,000.00 in funds from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources' Open Space Land Acquisition and Development (OSLAD) grant program for replacing the Spencer Park walking path; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Maroa upon award of the OSLAD funds, as the lead sponsor shall be responsible for securing local matching funds and/or in-kind services in an amount equaling at least fifty percent (50%) of construction costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Maroa upon award of the OSLAD funds, as the lead sponsor shall be responsible for securing local funds in an amount equaling one hundred percent (100%) of costs for grant ineligible items (as required); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Maroa supports believes it is in the best interests of the City of Maroa to support the efforts outlined herein;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MAROA, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** The City of Maroa supports the submittal of an application to IDNR's OSLAD program for the replacement of the Spencer Park walking path;

**SECTION TWO:** The City of Maroa affirms its commitment to \$60,000.00 in local funding as the required maximum of fifty percent match for a \$60,000.00 application for OSLAD funding;

**SECTION THREE:** That the Mayor, City Administrator, City Clerk, and City Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign any paperwork necessary for the submittal of the application;

**SECTION FOUR:** The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated in this Section 4 as if said recital were fully set forth.


**SECTION FIVE:** The provisions of the Resolution are severable and if any court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any portion of this Resolution to be invalid or unenforceable, said decision shall not affect any portion of this Resolution other than the part declared invalid or unenforceable. The City of Maroa hereby declares that it would have enacted this Resolution even with the invalid or unenforceable portion deleted.

**SECTION SIX:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.


**SECTION SEVEN:** Any resolution or motion in conflict with this Resolution is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts with this Resolution.
