POLICE BOARD MEETING
07/12/2016 MINUTES

The Police Board Meeting started at 7:00pm with (Chairman) Alderman Wayne Kissinger, Police Board Member Tom Stoutenborough present along with Chief Scott Gaddy, Officer Jonathan Layendecker & Officer Chet Doty.

Shootings Around The Country: Chairman Kissinger just wanted PD Officers to keep aware of there surrounds and be protective of themselves while on patrol. Chief Gaddy added that ILEAS sent email out last week asking for All Law Enforcement Agencies & Officers to report all Threats to Law Enforcement Personnel or Department regardless Real or Fake.

2017 Ford Explorer Police Vehicle: Chief Gaddy advised have not heard anything this week sense last Board Meeting and will call Monday Morning for follow-up.

In-Car Mobile Computers: Chief Gaddy explained that we have not heard anything about the new computer and that Chief Gaddy spoke with Panasonic on the day of last Board Meeting, and was told would received a email that day - still have not gotten any emails.

Chief's Raise: Chairman Kissinger explained to BM Stoutenborough that at last Board Meeting, he asked for a \$3.00/\$4.00 or Even 15% Raise for the New Chief with it being Tabled to the Next Board Meeting to check the Budget.

Part-Time Applications: Chief Gaddy explained PD only received 3 Applications with only 1 meeting the Requirements set in the Ad. That person was Nick Massey who has approx. 15yrs of experience as a Police Officer. The Police Board Approved Nick Massey for Part-Time with Approval of City Board Members at next Board Meeting (July 25th, 2016). The Police Board authorized Chief Gaddy to get Nick & Chet down to St. Mary's Occupational Health Wellness for Drug / Physical Screen.

Building Entry Doors: Chief Gaddy address the issue with the PD Entry Door having screws missing or stripped out, tough to open/close in the summer months, locks not working correctly and that Chief Gaddy & Chief Wilkey both agreed the Doors are becoming Unsafe and Security Problem. That Double Doors to Rear of the Gym also will not address for the same reasons in the future.

Board Members Absent: BM Stoutenborough addressed that Fact that BM Peart has missed several Police Board Meetings and feels that next City Board Meeting that Chairman Kissinger needs to ask for a Replacement of a New Board Member do to lack of Board Member Peart to

the Police Board at next City Board Meeting (July 25th, 2016).

Police Department Dayshift Officer: BM Stoutenborough address the need of the City Hall needing to know which Police Officer is working the Dayshift so they know who to contacted during the day if needed. Chief Gaddy explained that No One outside the Police Department get a copy of the Police Schedule, but Chief Gaddy agreed to have the Officer working Dayshift too stop in with the Mail and let the City Hall know which Officer is working.
