POLICE REPORT:

- Administrator Agee and Chief Fitzgerald are working on updating the electric scooter/ E-Bike ordinance. Currently, some ordinance language conflicts with State Statues, as well as other sections of the Maroa City Code due to age, and technological advancements. This is an informational statement for now. It is important for the Council to be aware we have already had seven documented complaints from Maroa citizens this spring. Olivia Lily is a concerned resident who came to the meeting tonight regarding this matter.
- Golf cart registrations begin this month. The police department has moved away from a card style registration for multiple reasons. We will be issuing a fade resistant sticker style.

ATTORNEY REPORT:

• Attorney Wise is working on the inter-governmental agreement for school traffic control. She has a draft for Administrator Agee and Chief Fitzgerald to look over.

Attorney Wise also has something for closed session due to it involving litigation.

ENGINEER REPORT:

ADMINISTRATOR/ZONING REPORT:

- The FY 2023-2024 GATA CYEFR has been completed and filed.
- Administrator Agee has reached out to see if there is anything we can do to decrease
 the amount of spam we have been receiving on City phones. In June, AT&T is
 eliminating the ability to bulk text directly from computer systems, which should greatly
 decrease spam calls. Administrator Agee will also be installing the AT&T Active Armor
 application on all City phones.
- Administrator Agee will be meeting with department heads to create the upcoming budget. Following any additions or corrections, a final draft will be created for the May 5th, 2025, regular meeting.
- As per Ordinance 2023/05/01-1, water and sewer rates are projected as follows, effective for the May-June billing cycle, payable in June:

In-town \$8.42 per 1000 gallons Out-of-town \$10.95 per 1000 gallons Bulk water \$10.50 per 1000 gallons

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- Administrator Agee is requesting to have the locks and keys changed at City Hall, specifically the Locust and Main Street entrances. Doing so will allow us to better account for outstanding keys for security purposes.
- Administrator Agee will be putting together a proposal for repairing and expanding the Spencer Park walking path. The goal is to apply for grants, including OSLAD.
- Top Quality Roofing has inspected the City Hall roof and made repairs to some boots and joints. There was no charge for the repairs. Damaged ceiling tiles have been replaced.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT:

The guys will be flushing hydrants starting April 21st and will probably last for about three
weeks.
