Position Summary

Part-Time Police Officers perform general law enforcement duties, including patrol, traffic enforcement, criminal investigations, ordinance enforcement, emergency response, conflict resolution and community policing activities. Officers work under the direction of the Chief of Police and are expected to uphold the highest standards of integrity and professionalism.

Minimum Qualifications

Applicants must:

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Be a United States citizen or otherwise legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Possess a valid Illinois driver's license.
- Be certified as a Law Enforcement Officer by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB) or be eligible for certification.
- Have no felony convictions or disqualifying criminal history.
- Must meet all Illinois FOID card requirements.
- Meet all requirements established by Illinois law and department policy.
- Successfully complete a background investigation, psychological evaluation, medical examination, and drug screening.

Preferred Qualifications

- Prior law enforcement experience.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Commitment to community policing and public service.

Compensation

- Competitive hourly wage based on qualifications and experience.
- Flexible scheduling.
- Opportunities for additional shifts and specialized assignments, as available.

- Copy of Illinois law enforcement certification (if applicable).
- Any additional documentation requested by the department.
